




Olsson Residence

This project aim is to design a minimalist contemporary villa for a Swedish family who recently moved to Qatar. The design decisions are derived from the Lagom and Hygge philosophies that focus on creating a cozy, warm, simple, and clutter-free atmosphere. Furthermore, having a neutral color palette and making the space more familiar by overusing wood and natural materials that are heavily used in Scandinavian interiors. The design also emphasizes on having a comfortable and safe interior for autistic people and elderly. This is achieved by: implementing non-slippery finishes for the floors such as wood, having a non-crowded space, and an enclosed plan to separate rooms; to help associate each room with the activity it is used for only.




Ground Floor Plan


Living Room




1. Carpet to reduce the noise



Kid Bedroom






Kid Bedroom Render



